 - obligation of mobility plans for companies?
 - contribution of employer in transport costs?
 - average cost of public transport for home work
 - →cost of monthly ticket for PT-trip of 30minutes by bus, tram, metro, train,...
 - →contribution by employer?

 - specific aspects in your country

- ▶ theoretical part
 - clear description of different mobility problems for commuters in your country, considering
 - environmental issues
 - social aspects (exclusion,...)
 - legal and fiscal aspects
 - health aspects
 - economical aspects
 - **-** . . .
 - specific aspects in your country

- ▶ theoretical part
 - description of the role and experience of trade unions (or other employees involvement) in the field of mobility management
 - is sustainable mobility an issue for trade unions?
 - is mobility part of negotations
 - -national level?
 - -company level?
 - what is the focus (accidents, exclusion,...)?
 - **.**...
 - specific aspects in your country

- ▶ theoretical part
 - short description of some good practices
 - initiatives by trade unions
 - by local authorities
 - by individual companies, industrial areas,...

- limited text, focus on what is important
